RECOMMENDED BY BONA VIDA CABO DE LA VELA AND PUNTA GALLINA (3 DAYS AND 2 NIGHTS)

DAY ONE:



8:00am Departure from Riohacha to Cabo de la Vela. We will visit the following attractions: Manaure, salt flats of Manaure, salt hills, Uribia (indigenous capital of Colombia), cactus forests, Carrizal Desert.

12:30pm Lunch in Cabo de la Vela
In the afternoon we will visit Arcoíris
Beach, Pilón de Azúcar hill, Dorada Beach
right next to the Pilón de Azúcar hill, Ojo de
Agua Beach. Later we will watch the
multicolored sunset from the hill of the

lighthouse. **7:00pm** dinner in Cabo de la Vela Accommodation in Cabo de la Vela in comfortable chinchorros



DAY TWO:

Breakfast in Cabo de la Vela

7:30am Departure to Punta Gallinas We will visit the following attractions: Jepirachi wind farm, Puerto Nuevo and Portete Desert, Bahía Honda Desert, Bahía Honda and the Desert of Bahía Hondita and we will have time to swim at Taroa Beach.

12:30m Lunch and rest in comfortable hammocks overlooking Taroa Beach.

In the afternoon we will visit the Dunes of Taroa with its fascinating landscape and contrasting sky, desert and sea. Here we will have the chance to swim or to do sand boarding.

5:00pm We will visit the lighthouse of Punta Gallinas located in the northernmost part of South America and afterwards we will watch the sunset from the Punta Agujas Beach.

7:00pm Dinner in Punta Gallinas. Accommodation in Punta Gallinas in comfortable chinchorros.

CABO DE LA VELA (2 DAYS, 1 NIGHT)



DAY ONE:

Departure from Riohacha at 8:30am.

We will visit the following attractions: Manaure, Manaure salt flats, salt hills, Uribia (indigenous capital of Colombia), cactus forests, Carrizal Desert.

Afterwards we will have lunch and some time to rest at the beach.

In the afternoon we will visit the Arcoíris Beach and Ojo de Agua Beach where we can enjoy the breeze of the Caribbean Sea. Later we will watch the multicolored sunset

from the hill of the lighthouse. Dinner and accommodation in a comfortable chinchorro (hammock).

DAY TWO:

Breakfast Walk to the Pilón de Azúcar hill with great views of the contrasting, desert, sky and sea. Then we will have some time to swim at Dorada Beach right next to Pilón de Azúcar hill. Lunch and return to Riohacha.

This trip includes: Food and accommodation at posada turistica Pujurú in Cabo de la Vela. Transportation in a Toyota 4x4 shared with 4 to 6 people and insurance with coverage for accidents inside the vehicle. Spanish speaking guide. The itinerary for day one and two may vary. Operated by a partner agency.

- Transfer to the indigenous Wayuu community 20 minutes from Riohacha and back to the hostel
- Ecological trail to the Ranchería River
- Introduction to culture
- We will teach you to create Wayuu fabrics made by yourself, to create and play Wayuu instruments or create handmade paintings

Local **Spanish speaking** guide, art materials, hydration and drinks,

transportation from the hostel-community-hostel

CAMARONES BEACH WITH VISIT TO THE SANCTUARY OF FAUNA AND FLORA OF BOCA CAMARONES (ONE DAY TRIP)



Departure from
Riohacha to
Camarones **9:00am**Canoe ride through the sanctuary
lagoon.

A trained guide will take us on a traditional paddle canoe through the lagoons of the

sanctuary to observe pink flamingos and a variety of native and migratory birds. The guide will explain interesting details about their food source, reproduction etc.

Afterwards we will have lunch and some time to relax at the beach

This trip includes: Transportation, guidance, lunch with drink. Spanish speaking guide. The itinerary may vary according to weather conditions. Depending on the season the number of flamingos varies. Operated by a partner travel agency.

CABO DE LA VELA AND PUNTA GALLINAS (TWO DAYS, ONE NIGHT)

DAY ONE:

Departure from Riohacha at **7:00am** directly to Punta Gallinas through cactus forests, Carrizal Desert, herds of goats and sheep around the rancherías.

Arrival at Taroa Beach, lunch, departure to the Dunes of Taroa, bath at the dunes of Taroa Beach. You will visit the lighthouse to watch the sunset from the northernmost tip of the Guajira peninsula. Dinner in Punta Gallinas. Accommodation in chinchorros.



DAY TWO:

Breakfast in Punta Gallinas. Departure to Cabo de la Vela. Lunch in Cabo de la Vela in front of the beach. You will visit Pilon de Azúcar and Playa Dorada and then depart to Riohacha.

Spanish speaking guide. The itinerary may vary according to weather conditions. Operated by a partner agency.

Price COP 570,000 P/P to 630,000 P/P

12:30pm Lunch in Cabo de la Vela

In the afternoon we will visit Arcoíris Beach, Pilón de Azúcar hill, Dorada Beach right next to the Pilón de Azúcar hill and

Ojo de Agua Beach. In the late afternoon we will watch the multicolored sunset from the hill of the lighthouse.

7:00pm dinner in Cabo de la Vela and accommodation in Cabo de la Vela in comfortable chinchorros



DAY TWO:

Departure to Nazareth. We will visit the following attractions: Jepirachi wind farm, Portete Bay viewpoint, Warreo Desert, Puerto Nuevo and Portete Desert, Bahía Honda Desert, Bahía Honda, Nazareth.

Accommodation in Nazareth in comfortable chinchorros.

DAY THREE:



We will visit the MAKUIRA national park (oasis in the desert). In the middle of the immense desert rises the mountain range of the Makuira with forests and lush vegetation, streams and cascades of crystalline water. This visit is carried out with the assistance of trained indigenous Wayuu people.

Lunch in Nazareth and then departure to Punta Gallinas where we will visit the Taroa Dunes, Taroa Dune beaches, Hondita Bay and watch the sunset by the lighthouse.

Accommodation in Punta Gallinas in comfortable chinchorros.

DAY FOUR:

Departure to Riohacha and lunch in Uribia.

This trip includes: Food, transportation in a Toyota 4x4 shared with 4 to 6 people and insurance with coverage for accidents inside the vehicle and accommodation in confortable chinchorros. Spanish speaking guide. The itinerary may vary according to weather conditions. Operated by a partner agency.

Price COP 1,310,000 P/P to COP 1,490,000 P/P in a shared car of 5 to 6 people.

There is the option to sleep in a bed in a private room which has an additional cost of **40,000 P/P** a night. Prices depend on the season. Please confirm with reception.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- There is a surcharge for credit/debit card payments of 3-4%
- Children under 4 years do not pay
- The itinerary may vary according to weather conditions
- The food will be made with typical regional foods such as: fish, meat, chicken, goat. Vegetarian and vegan options are available but very limited
- Have lobster or prawns for an extra cost
- We will sleep in typical Wayuu chinchorros in huts where we can enjoy the pleasant breeze of La Guajira's nights
- There are plenty of bathrooms available
- The rooms are ecological and have electric power service until a certain hour at night
- The tour takes place in Spanish, if you prefer a bilingual guide there is an additional cost of approximately \$ 250,000 per day

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Take a small and comfortable bag with you since space in the vehicle is limited. If you have large luggage you can leave it in the hostel's storage room for free.

is lt important bring comfortable clothes, towels, sunscreen, hats, caps, toiletries, flashlight and tennis with you.

Hydration is not included, it can be

purchased during the tour in Uribia or Riohacha.
